Another Kateri Relic Found

At the bishop's residence in Chicoutini, Quebec, a discovery was recently made of a relic of Kateri Tekakwitha described as 6.4 cm in length and 3.8 cm in breadth and seems to have been the foresection of the sternum. The description was confirmed by Dr. Dominic Gaudry, general practitioner at the Hotel Dieu St. Vallier of Chicoutini from 1935 to 1952, who examined this part of the bone.

The envelope containing the bone has the following identification: "Picture and relic of the Iroquois Maiden, Catherine Tekakwitha, who died in the odor of holiness at the Village of Sault St. Louis, P.Q., on April 17, 1680. Given by Rev. Father V. Burtin, O.M.I."

Remains of Kateri are scarce since some of Kateri's relics among them the skull were destroyed when the church at St. Regis burned to the ground. In 1972 the remaining relics of Kateri were solemnly laid to rest in a tomb within the interior of the mission church, Kahnawake, Canada.

Plans for 1982 Unfold Feast Day Event May 2

Bishop Howard J. Hubbard, bishop of Albany, will celebrate Blessed Kateri's Feast Day Mass on Sunday, 4 P.M., May 2, 1982, in the Shrine Coliseum at Auriesville, N.Y. Vice Chancellor Father Edward C. Pratt will give the homily.

Beginning at 2 P.M. the same afternoon 15 students — the Rainbow Clowns — will present a set of skits including one on the life of Bl. Kateri. Following this program outdoor devotions with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will take place at the openair Tekakwitha Statue.

The Rainbow Chorus Ministries of Albany, N.Y., which won universal approval last year, will return to provide the liturgical singing for the Mass. This group will also come later in the season to present its Family program.

Tentatively scheduled for a July or August date is the Christian Music Ministries, an interdenominational singing-drama troupe, which thrilled an audience with "The Witness" billing, July, 1981.

Sunday, May 2, opens the Martyrs Shrine season.

Monthly discussions by the Mohawk Valley Associates are held to formulate arrangements for more events which will be listed in detail in the next LILY.

Matchstick Galleon Named After Kateri

"Ioragode," translated "Little Sunshine," was the name given Kateri after her birth by her parents because she brought much joy to their lives. Chosen again by David Pumerajo for his masterful craftsmanship, it is the third galleon made in honor of the Indian Maiden.

The ship is constructed out of match sticks, took five weeks to make, and will be a special display this year in the National Kateri Center. Each of the symbols of the 3 major Mohawk clans, bear, wolf, and turtle, are shown on the ship's sails. A Kateri medal is affixed to the steering column.

A photo of the presentation of the frigate to Fr. McBride for the Center was made at a Legion of Mary Meeting, Dec. 23 1981, Comstock, N.Y., and will be run in the next LILY. David is the president of the Legion.

KATERI'S INTERCESSION - SOME ANSWERS

HERE'S FAITH

This letter is long overdue, mainly because I didn't know how to begin. Over the past several years I've prayed for the intercession of Kateri to grant several favors. She has granted them all. Each time I promised that if my prayers were answered I would acknowledge them by writing to you. Each time I have been remiss in doing so, but she still intercedes in my behalf.

Seven years ago was when I first started asking. My father was scheduled for a second operation to correct an osteomyelitis complication that resulted from open heart surgery. Earlier this year, when Jim Brady, the President's Press Secretary, was shot and his prognosis was poor, I asked for her intercession. The next morning his outlook improved and has since made a remarkable recovery. I'm a nurse and I recognize the great capabilities of all the new advanced medical technologies now available. But in this instance, I believe everyone's prayers had to be a determinant factor.

Just recently I had a severe sore throat for over two weeks and after a few days of prayer for Kateri's intercession, I recovered.

The object of this letter is that I am very interested in the possible canonization of Kateri. According to my limited understanding of the procedure she needs more miracles to her credit. I realize nothing I've written about would be considered a miracle, but to me her record is faultless.

Fr. Barney Fagan, former superior of the St. Francis Mission (Sioux) in South Dakota, wrote: "I was deeply inspired by the 1981 Tekakwitha Conference at Albuquerque — especially by the evident love and trust which various tribes from all over the country have toward Kateri. They seem to feel strongly that under her banner Native Americans can find a better road in the future. Many persons (Indian) showed this devotion at the Conference."

On Jan. 1 the League representative Anne Scheuerman of Pittsford, N.Y., left for India and will visit several league members in Sri Lanka.

"Youth for Kateri" by Cathy Walton, a special column about activities of young people who love Blessed Kateri, will not be run in the LILY for a while. Cathy is on a leave of absence. Her daughter Alison and Olga Falco, former shrine office attendant, will substitute as secretary and receptionist.

The League's Board has approved the expenditure of \$3500 to build an office-workroom addition to the Longhouse, the head-quarters of the League and residence of the Vice Postulator.

planned to give more persons a chance to participate in the work of the Tekakwitha Conference which has held annual meetings in the mid-West, a distance those in the East cannot travel without extra burdens of expense and time.

Happily Mary-Eunice of Mary Productions informed me that her cassette on Kateri has gone to India, the Philippines, and to the outback in Australia, and will be used on radio. Same cassette may be purchased from the League Office for \$5.50 which includes postage.

January 11, a very cold winter night, found the Mohawk Valley Kateri Associates meeting in the home of Dick and Ann Marie Adach's home in Gloversville, N.Y. The home was consecrated to the Heart of Jesus since the theme of the evening's liturgy dealt with Kateri's acceptance into the Holy Family Association. During the business meeting the program for May 2, celebration of Kateri's Feast Day was firmed up and is given on the front page of this LILY.

And back in Wisconsin the Episcopal Church Women of Holy Apostles Church noted their pilgrimage to Auriesville and Fonda in their tribal newspaper on the Oneida Reservation. "Our new statue (of Kateri) which we acquired on our pilgrimage can be seen in the Convent yard of Holy Apostles Church," wrote Nori Damrow.

Your generosity and that of the League's many friends enabled us to deposit \$9,000 in the savings account and in two certificates of deposit. It seems inadvisable to print the 1981 ledgers as it does to list amounts after donors' names.
