
LOVING


Through the teaching on LOVING, children learn that love is shared by sincere actions rather than by empty words. Loving, caring, and helping people in everyday life makes the world a better place. Merely talking about loving isn't enough. The attitudes and examples of the family have the greatest influence on whether children grow up to be generous or selfish. They learn to share their own talents and gifts when they see adults care for the sick, help the needy, treat others with respect, and pray with others.


The two greatest commandments are to love God and to love our neighbor as ourselves. Jesus teaches us both by word and example.




As I grow older, I learn to love others more.













Here are the names and pictures of people I care about.
